It is in the interest of the safety of all that every student and parent is aware of the safety guidelines, rules and regulations outlined below.

We are extremely proud of the safe and efficient transportation system our school district has provided in the past. We invite you and your son/daughter to join us as we continue to celebrate our success shared as a safe and efficient transportation system. In order to do so, we ask everyone to continue to abide by the rules and regulations of the AAPS Rights and Responsibilities Policy and the AAPS Transportation System.

1. All bus students are required to follow the rules and regulations of the Ann Arbor Public School District's Transportation Policy.
 - Please sign and return the AAPS Transportation form for all bus students to the driver.
2. At all times The Rights and Responsibilities Poiciary of the AAPS will be enforced while students are transported to and from school. Failure to do so will result in loss of privileges.
 - Loss of transportation privileges could result as a consequence of a violation of the AAPS Rights and Responsibilities Poiciary. .
3. Students who fail to follow listed rules or the direction of a driver or transportation monitor will receive a written bus referral. Upon receipt of the third (3rd) referral, he/she will temporarily lose bus privileges.
(The number of days will be determined by severity of offense.)
STUDENTS MAY LOSE BUS PRIVILEGES UPON AN INITIAL REFERRAL BASED ON THE VIOLATION OF THE RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES POLICY.

The School/AAPS Transportation System will respond to parent concerns in a timely manner and seek resolution to all concerns.

Please instruct your son/daughter to report any concern to the driver, parent, or school official if he/she feels threatened on our busses.
